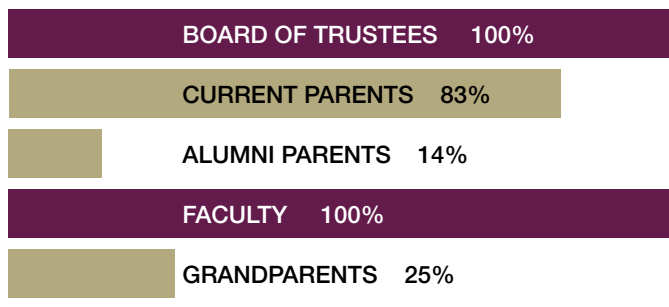
2014-2015 Impact

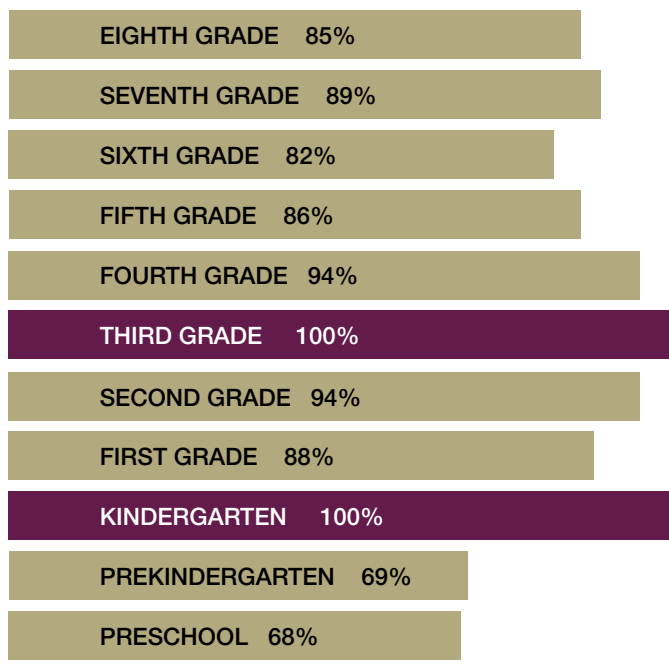
The success of donations made to St. Anne's School had a significant impact on the student experience by allowing the school to:

PARENT PARTICIPATION BY GRADE

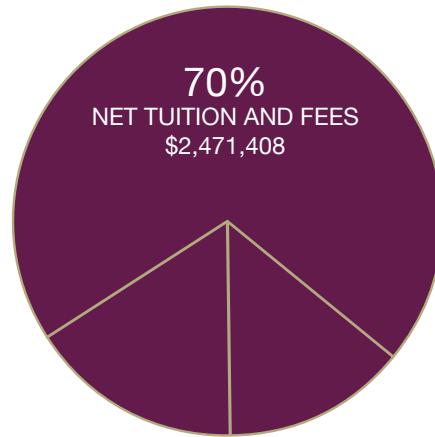

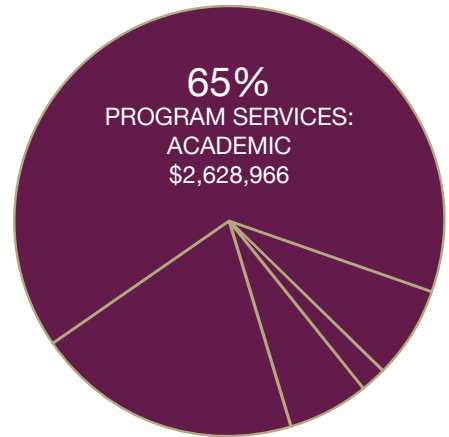

Honoring Sarah McMahan, a St. Anne's School student who passed away from leukemia in 2012, this 5 kilometer run/walk raises funds to support a St. Anne's School scholarship in Sarah's memory. In 2014, the event also benefited cancer research through Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation, a national non-profit dedicated to eradicating childhood cancer by funding cancer research and awareness.

The event included participants from the St. Anne's School community, as well as from the surrounding Anne Arundel County area. This meaningful community building event would not be possible without the generosity of sponsors, donors and participants. Thank you for making a difference for those families who are effected by cancer, in our school community and beyond.

The Run for Sarah is officially certified by USA Track & Field (USATF), which serves as the National Governing Body for track and field, long-distance running and race walking in the United States. Forward Momentum

IN A BOLD DIRECTION

GUIDED BY THE forward thinking vision developed by the St. Anne's School community in the 2014–2017 Strategic Plan: *Inspire, Inquire, Innovate*, the Board of Trustees undertook a “campaign feasibility study” in the fall of 2014. The feasibility study was part of a long-term plan to invest in the smart growth and sustainability of St. Anne's School by examining the impact and viability of a capital campaign at this exciting juncture in the life of the school.



A campaign feasibility study is a measuring tool used to determine if a fundraising campaign has the ingredients it needs for success. Independent schools rely on three primary sources of annual income: tuition, donations (i.e. the Annual Fund) and endowment income. These three annual funding sources provide operational “dollars to live by.” Funds raised in periodic capital campaigns significantly move a school strategically forward in great strides by providing “dollars to grow by.”

To implement the study, the Board contracted Graham-Pelton Consulting, Inc., a nationally recognized consulting and management firm for non-profits and independent schools. Over three months, Graham-Pelton collaborated with the school community through a series of in-person interviews, strategic discussions, and an e-survey that was sent to the broad St. Anne's School community—current and alumni. In total, 88 individuals participated in the study.

Throughout the study, the proposed funding priorities for a capital campaign that resonated the most with the St. Anne's School community reflected those priorities identified in the 2014–2017 Strategic Plan: *Inspire, Inquire, Innovate* as measures that will position the school to thrive well into the future and ultimately stimulate continued enrollment growth.

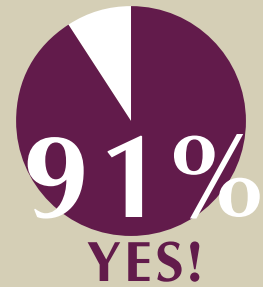

Based on the overwhelmingly positive and thoughtful feedback from feasibility study participants, careful fundraising analysis carried out by the St. Anne's School Development Office, and the recommendations of Graham Pelton, the St. Anne's School Board of Trustees unanimously endorsed the feasibility study recommendations and voted to proceed with the planning phase of a capital campaign to invest in the campus, faculty, programs, and long-term financial sustainability of St. Anne's School.

The future is bright with opportunity, as our community moves forward together—thoughtful of the past, engaged in the present, and focused on the horizon. 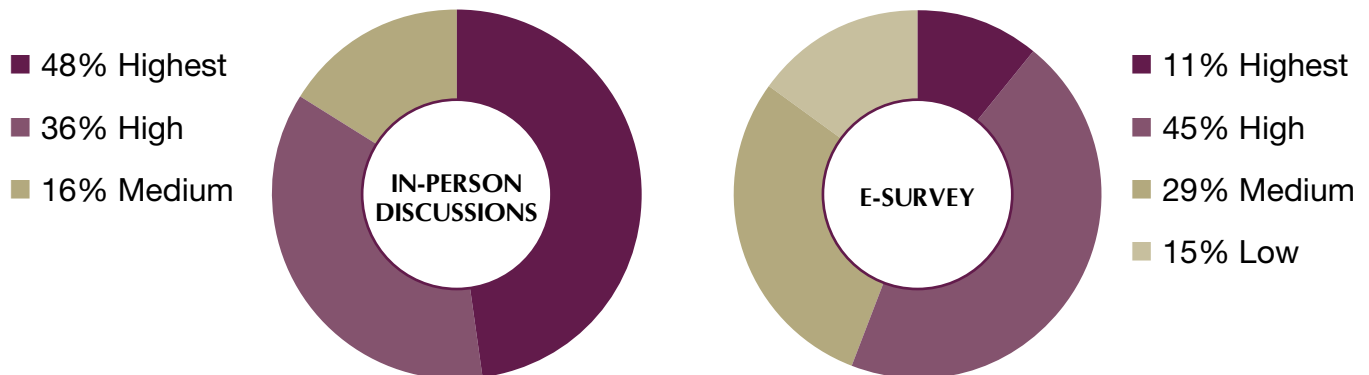
