



Important Deadlines for Financial Aid Applicants

A Step-by-Step Schedule for the 2010-2011 School Year

Financial Aid packets for the St. Anne's School of Annapolis 2010-2011 academic year will be mailed to all families currently receiving financial aid on November 2, 2009. Families of current students who do not currently receive aid, but wish to apply for the upcoming school year, may obtain a packet from the Financial Aid Office by contacting our Director of Financial Aid, Sandi Hiller, at 410.263.8650, ext. 133 or shiller@St.AnnesSchool.org.

Families of new students applying for admission for the 2010-2011 school year may obtain a Financial Aid packet from the Financial Aid Office beginning December 1, 2009.

Step 1 Complete the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) using the St. Anne's School of Annapolis code (6315). Submit it directly to the School and Student Service for Financial Aid. This statement is available in your Financial Aid packet and is also available online at: <http://sss.nais.org>.

You will need to retain a copy of this statement for submission to the St. Anne's School Financial Aid Office as noted in Step 2.

Deadline: February 1, 2010, for returning families
March 31, 2010, for new families

Step 2 Complete the St. Anne's School of Annapolis Financial Aid Application (found in the Financial Aid packet and available for download on our Web site) and submit it directly to the school's Financial Aid Office along with a copy of your PFS. In order to be considered for financial aid, returning families must have submitted their re-enrollment contract and deposit; new families must have completed their application for admission and had an enrollment contract offered by the school.

Deadline: March 1, 2010, for returning families
March 31, 2010, for new families

Step 3 Submit a copy of your 2009 Federal Income Tax Return to the St. Anne's School Financial Aid Office. Please Note: If you estimated your income when completing the PFS, and there is a discrepancy between this estimate and the actual data on your 2009 income tax return, the Financial Aid Committee may make an adjustment to any financial aid award previously granted for the 2010-2011 academic year.

Deadline: April 15, 2010, for both new and returning families
